Treasures Report (Amber Brookins): RCP general funds = \$6,264.42; DOW Grant = \$2032.15; Waterloo Camp = \$700.00; OEEF = \$2540.00; RCWTA = \$1286.18; Total RCP Account as of 5/25/11 = \$12813.75; Total Account increase from 4/27/11 to 5/25/11 = 42477.97

Fundraising Committee Report (Amber Brookins): These years the Fundraising Committee decided not to conduct a raffle. There will be grafted trees to sell at the Paw Paw Festival. An idea was proposed to print some RCP shirts to sell at events. There is a bake sale taking place on Friday, June 10th in Athens. There will be baking going on at Amber's house on the 9th. There is also potential for having a benefit show at CASA this summer.

Coordinator Report (Amy Mackey): Amy received a letter from the Ohio Environmental Council (OEC) asking if RCP would like to become a member. The RCP Board voted to pay \$25.00 membership fee to OEC. Pre bid for Harble Griffith and Orland gob pile is completed and work is scheduled to begin in July of this year. Water Quality Specialist Report (Brian Blair): Water sampling is slow due to rainy weather and high flows. East Branch 2 is moving along, however the sand used for the filtering system was of poor quality and is clogging up the discharge. East Branch 3 is now on line but the valves that are being used leak water when they are closed. ODNR said they would replace every valve in East Branch 2 & 3. 50 additional tires were removed from the Flint Run area.

Waterloo Education Report (Heike Perko, Kara Walton, Sarah Landers): Heike Perko was hired as Camp Facilitator. The summer camps date is June 20th thru 24th and August 1st thru 5th. A committee meeting will be scheduled to finalize the agenda for the camps.

Water Trail (RCWTA) report (Molly Gurien): Annual Spring Float was May 1st with 10 paddlers. Water level was perfect. RCWTA annual dinner will be August 6th at the Vinton Village Park in Vinton Ohio in Gallia County. Ohio University Department of Recreation donated three canoes to RCWTA/RCP.
